

## Timeline Table

Scope	CT.Gov Requirements	Comments
<b>Registration</b>	No later than <b>21 days</b> after the first subject is enrolled  ICMJE requires that registration is complete <i>prior</i> to first subject enrollment	A study is considered 'registered' once the Responsible Party release the record to the PRS for review
<b>Active Enrollment/Verification Date</b>	Update/verification every <b>6 months, but no later than 12 months</b>	For studies that are not yet completed, even if there were no changes to the record. The Verification Date is located in the Protocol Section – Study Status
<b>Enrollment Closed</b>	Update/verification <b>annually</b>	Even if no changes or updates are made the registration record, the record <b>must</b> be verified annually
<b>Change in Study Status</b>	Within <b>30 days</b> of status change	Includes: Recruitment Status, Overall Recruitment Status, and Completion Date
<b>Pending Study Results</b>	Update/verification <b>annually</b>	Even if no changes or updates are made the registration record, the record <b>must</b> be verified annually
<b>Posting Study ICF</b>	After the study enrollment is closed, and no later than <b>60 days</b> after the last study visit of any subject	Upload the most recent IRB-Approved version of the consent form; blank/unsigned
<b>Result Submission</b>	No later than <b>1 year</b> after the primary completion date	Delayed results submission is allowed in some situations. Reference 42 CFR 11.44, (Extensions for Good Cause) for details
