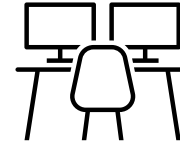


Elevate Your Research with a Self-Assessment Review

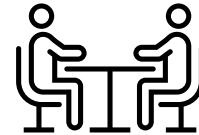
What is a Self-Assessment Review?

- A **Self-Assessment Review** is a tool provided by the OQC to assist investigators and research teams conducting research. A self assessment may be initiated by one of the following methods:
 - Voluntarily created or at the request of a member of the research team
 - Selection by the OQC to participate
 - Required by the OQC in conjunction with, or because of, a separate OQC review/assessment



How is it done?

- Once a Self-Assessment is completed by the research team and submitted, the OQC will contact the PI and research team to schedule a meeting to review the Self-Assessment, discuss any findings, and provide recommendations and resources for the team.
